FROM THE MANAGING ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

I am filled with such joy and gratitude to welcome you back to The 5 & Dime. This revival will never erase the pain, grief, or fear that we've all experienced over the last 15+ months; we send love and comfort to those who've been affected in any way—big or small—throughout this pandemic.

Returning to the stage at this time with this piece represents exactly what The 5 & Dime is committed to: telling stories that reflect the community we live in, spark conversation, and make change. This play offers a sense of urgency and a call to action that is amplified in a profound way from the events of the past year—all told by a man whose words have uplifted Black American voices for decades. August Wilson has given us an autobiography that's intricately layered with calls for social justice against a backdrop of his experience growing up as a Black artist in America.
